

## **East Kilbride Road Club 10 mile Time Trial League – 2007.**

### **League Rules**

- ❑ The East Kilbride Road Club 10-Mile Time Trial League shall be an annual competition, in which club members will compete in a season long competition for the East Kilbride Road Club Time Trial League Trophy.
- ❑ Dates for events for the league will be agreed by the Club Management Committee and posted on the club website, no later than March of each year. Six events will be run across the season, with the best four performances counting towards the Time Trial League.
- ❑ All events will be confined 10-mile time trials, run on the A77 circuit, with 3 mid week and 3 week-end events.
- ❑ Club members need not participate in all events to be eligible for the Time Trial League.
- ❑ Points for the League will be calculated using the 10-mile time trial handicap tables, which are published on the SCU website.
- ❑ Points will be awarded from 10 down to 1, with 10 points awarded for the fastest time calculated using the agreed handicap system. The 10<sup>th</sup> place rider in each event will score 1 point. If there are more than 10 riders in any given event, then riders who place lower than 10<sup>th</sup> place will score no points.
- ❑ Handicaps at the start of the season will be calculated from each club members best 10-mile time trial time during the previous racing season. Where no time trials have been ridden, a standard handicap of 4 minutes and 51 seconds will be applied.
- ❑ Handicaps are likely to be altered throughout the season, as and when club members improve on existing personal best times. Recalculations will be made using the SCU 10 mile time trial handicap tables.
- ❑ A time-keeper will be identified in advance of each event. The Time Trial Secretary will obtain the times from the time-keeper at the finish of each event.
- ❑ The Time Trial Secretary shall update the time trial league table within 2 weeks of each counting event and ensure that this is posted on the club website.
- ❑ Any disputes over calculations made in respect of handicaps and/or points scored should be referred to the Time Trial Secretary in the first instance. If the dispute remains unresolved, then this will be referred to the Club Management Committee for a final and binding decision.
- ❑ The winner of the East Kilbride Road Club 10-Mile Time Trial League shall receive a trophy, presented at the Club's annual awards presentation.

## **East Kilbride TT League Events**

**All events are 7pm start for Tuesdays, 10 am start for Sundays. All events will be held on A77, with start line just up from the golf club entrance. Course runs up to the roundabout just beyond Eaglesham Moor Road, turns at this point, returning to finish just beyond the golf club entrance.**
